Alberta Printmakers (A/P) invites all artists incorporating print media techniques within their practice to apply for our 2019 – 2020 juried gallery program.

Description

A/P programs 6 exhibitions per year in the Main Space Gallery, located in Calgary, Alberta. The gallery programming is determined by a selection committee and is based on the quality of the submissions. A/P provides a number of benefits for accepted proposals including: an event invitation, CARFAC fees, one-way shipping, and an invitation to attend the opening and give a public lecture about their work.

Gallery Mandate:

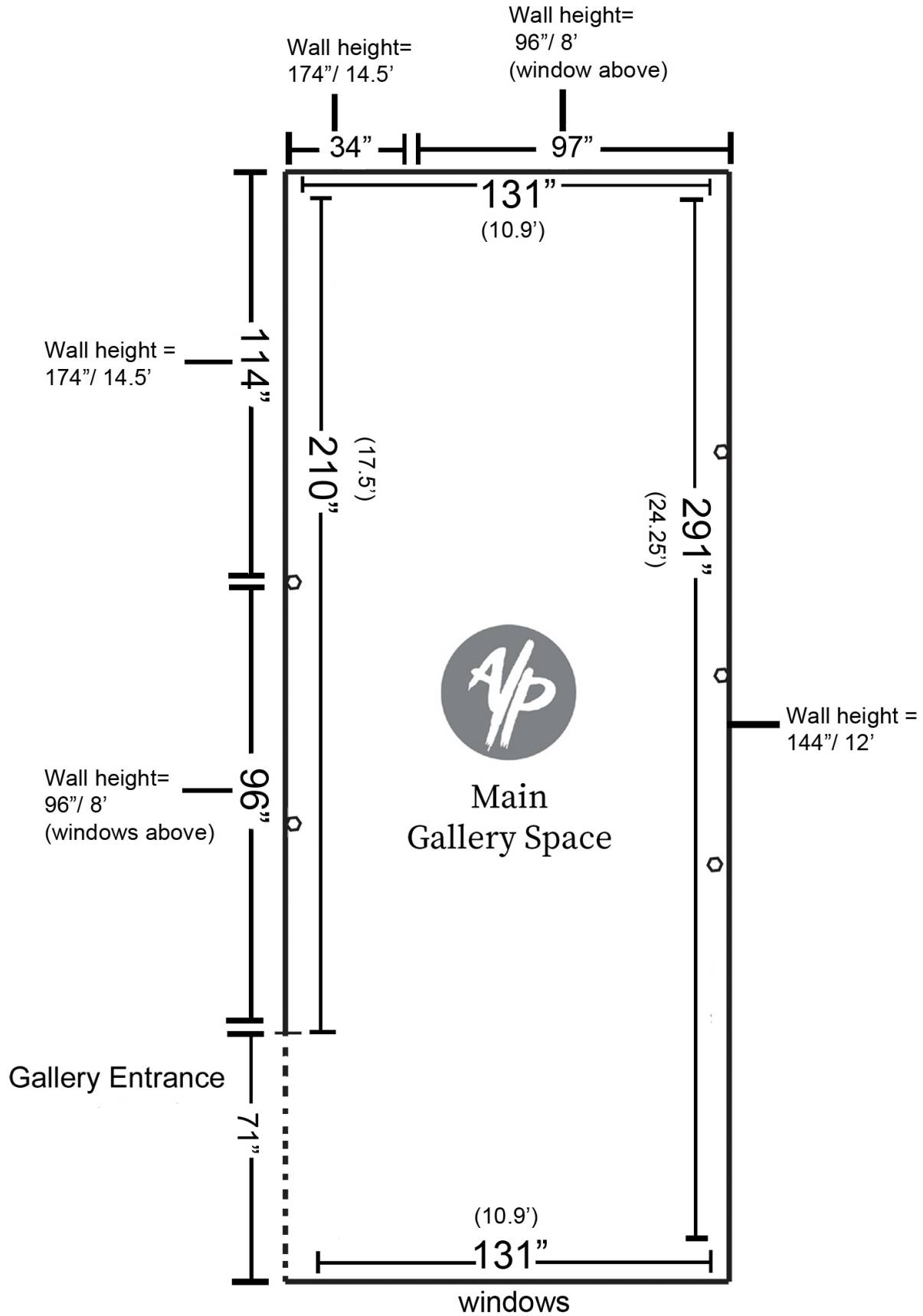
Alberta Printmakers Main Space Gallery is an artist-run gallery located within A/P's print center. The Main Space Gallery Program exhibits innovative, contemporary, print-based art produced from emerging, mid-career, and established artists. Print techniques can include any or a combination of: relief, intaglio, monoprint, lithography, silkscreen and digital. These techniques can also be combined with any other media such as, but not limited to fabric or ceramics. Alberta Printmakers Main Space Gallery shows regional, national and international artists working in a range of concepts and techniques. Our goal is to provide opportunities for the artistic and public communities to experience the diversity of print media art as a contemporary and vital artistic medium.

Alberta Printmakers Main Space Gallery Application Requirements 2019 – 2020

1. Applicants must submit a completed Main Space Gallery Application Form 2019 – 2020. This form is attached, and can be downloaded at www.albertaprintmakers.com
 2. Applicants must submit the following, and all files must be PC and MAC compatible:
 - **IMAGES**
Ten numbered & labeled digital images in JPEG format. Label and number images using the following format: 1.artistname_title.jpg
Each image must be 72 dpi and a maximum of 1200 pixels on the longest side.
 - **DIGITAL IMAGE LIST**
A corresponding digital image list that includes size, title of work, media and date for each image; in PDF format.
 - **STATEMENT**
An artist statement in PDF format.
 - **CURRICULUM VITAE**
CV must be no longer than 4 pages and in PDF format. Include full contact details and include current mailing address.
 - **PROPOSAL**
Written exhibition proposal in PDF format. Please refer to attached gallery map. Please note that one wall is painted cinder block (291” wall), and two walls are painted drywall.
 - **BIOGRAPHY**
Artist biography for promotional material, no longer than 50 words.
- Submissions must be received no later than 4pm on October 8, 2018. Incomplete submissions and submissions that do not follow the format described above will not be reviewed.
3. Applications must be submitted by e-mailed no later than 4:00 p.m. on October 8, 2018. E-mail applications to apgallerychair@gmail.com and address email with the following in the ‘subject’ line: Main Space Submission 2019-2020.
