Auditions and interviews take place in person on **Monday April 25<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022**. Slots are 15 minutes in length, and take place in the Quest Theatre Rehearsal Hall, cSPACE, King Edward, 1721 - 29 Ave S.W. Suite 325 in Calgary, Alberta. Although we strongly support our local Alberta theatre community, we welcome the opportunity to meet artists from other provinces.

### **For Performers:**

Auditions are open to Equity and Non-Equity artists. As Quest Theatre is a professional touring company, artists must perform during the day and cannot be enrolled as full or part-time students as of September 2022. Auditions will be **in-person** unless Alberta government regulations change. Video auditions are possible by request.

Please prepare two contrasting monologues that take no longer than 3 minutes together. Pieces do not have to be TYA in content.

Quest Theatre is a member of the Professional Association of Canadian Theatres and operates within the jurisdiction of the Canadian Theatre Agreement. Equity members cast in any production will be engaged under an Equity form of contract.
