- Support all four Kids & Music Groups (Pre-Kindergarten, Kindergarten, Grade 1 and Grade 2) in our Christmas and Year-End recitals
- Have a general knowledge of the vocal as well as the piano music assigned, so they may support the children by singing as directed
- Be pleasant, kind, gentle, and caring around children
- Be prepared to substitute teach a class should the Director be ill or absent
