Key responsibilities:

Reporting to the Artistic Director, the Young Singers Director's primary duties will be to lead a weekly 60 minute music class from September to May for boys Kindergarten to Grade 2, focusing on choral skills and musicianship

Additional duties:

- Assist/conduct rehearsals and performances with the other Calgary Boys' Choir ensembles, as required
- Attend all classes and any extra mutually agreed upon events as outlined in the season calendar.
- Participate in fundraising events and other administrative duties as required.
- Communicate regularly and openly with the artistic and administrative staff, keeping abreast of all information as outlined in choir memos.
- Attend all Artistic Meetings and occasional board meetings
- Other duties may be requested by the Artistic Director and will be discussed as they arise.

Qualifications:

- Undergraduate degree in music education or performance
- Early childhood music education experience/pedagogy an asset
- Conducting experience of 2-5 years, with at least one year conducting children
- Experience teaching children and youth
- An understanding of vocal pedagogy
- Excellent theory and musicianship skills
- Proficient piano skills (for rehearsing and basic accompaniment)
- Strong organizational and interpersonal skills
- Positive and enthusiastic attitude
