 - Post-secondary education in Visual Arts, Fine Arts, or a related field and/or a recognized teaching certification in Visual Arts, Fine Arts, or a related field is required.
- Level 2 Instructors must have the following qualifications:
 - An advanced post-secondary education in Visual Arts, Fine Arts, or a related field and/or a recognized advanced teaching certification in Visual Arts, Fine Arts, or a related field is required.
 - At least 3 years of instructional experience in visual arts is required.
 - An extensive personal base of resource material in the field is essential.
 - Recognition as an "authority" in your field by an institution, peers and/or public.
 - Ability to develop a curriculum-based program.
- Strong communication skills along with demonstrated initiative, planning, and organizational skills.
- Sound judgment in safety standards and well-developed customer service skills.
- Practicing artist with portfolio will be required to bring sample artworks.
