WHAT YOU'LL DO

Casino Volunteers may be assigned to roles such as:

- chip runner
- banker
- count room support
- general casino floor support

- Volunteers who are reliable, detail-oriented, and comfortable following procedures.
- Those able to commit to a scheduled shift on May 25 or 26, 2026.
- Volunteers interested in supporting behind-the-scenes fundraising efforts.
- Individuals comfortable working in a structured, regulated environment.

Please note: Casino roles require adherence to AGLC regulations and may require advance training or documentation.
